# A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL APPOINTING CERTAIN ELECTED OFFICIALS AND STAFF MEMBERS TO VARIOUS REGIONAL AND LOCAL BOARDS AND COMMITTEES FOR 2023

### THE CITY COUNCIL City of Glendora, California

- WHEREAS, annually the City Council reviews and makes certain appointments to various regional and local boards and committees of which the City is a member or has a community interest in; and,
- **WHEREAS**, assignments to the City Selection Committee per CA Government Code Section 50270 and County Sanitation District No. 22 per California Health and Safety Code Section 4730 required the sitting Mayor to be the delegate representative; and,
- **WHEREAS**, the San Gabriel Valley Council of Governments bylaws require the City legislative body to formally adopt a resolution specifically indicating the delegate and alternate representing the City to be assigned to their governing body; and,
- WHEREAS, the Independent Cities Risk Management Authority (ICRMA), a joint powers authority created pursuant to the provisions of the California Government Code, the Joint Powers Agreement provides that the legislative body adopt a resolution specifically indicating the city's delegate, alternate and substitute alternate representatives to the ICRMA Governing Board to represent the city's interest; and,
- **WHEREAS**, on August 24, 2021, per City Council Policy (Resolution CC 2021-43), the City Council approved the Mayor to be the Alternate to Metro Gold Line Foothill Extension Construction Authority (JPA) each year, unless the Mayor is the Delegate, at which time the City Council will select an Alternative.

## NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDORA, CALIFORNIA, DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

- **SECTION 1**. The attached exhibit listing Board and Committee appointments (Exhibit A) has been reviewed and accepted by the City Council indicating various persons and titles assigned to represent the interest of the City of Glendora.
- **SECTION 2**. The appointments to the Cal Cities LA Division shall be Council Member Karen Davis as delegate, Council Member Michael Allawos will continue to serve as alternate.
- **SECTION 3**. The appointment to the San Gabriel Valley Protection Association shall be Council Member David Fredendall as delegate, and Mayor Gary Boyer as alternative (subject to appointment change to the Rivers and Mountains Conservancy).
- **SECTION 4**. The appointment to the San Gabriel Valley Water Association shall be Public Works Assistant Director Chisom Obegolu as delegate and Council Member David Fredendall as alternate.

**SECTION 5**. The appointments of delegates and alternates to all other regional and local boards and committees shall remain unchanged.

**SECTION 6**. Authorize City Clerk to update and post FPPC Form 806 Agency Report of Public Official Appointments.

**SECTION 7**. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and shall enter the same in the Book of Original Resolutions.

**SECTION 8.** The City Clerk is hereby directed to forward a copy of this resolution to the various bodies listed indicating the appointments as approved by the City Council action
