

**RESOLUTION CC 2020-15**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDORA, CALIFORNIA, RECITING THE FACT OF THE GENERAL MUNICIPAL ELECTION HELD ON MARCH 3, 2020, DECLARING THE RESULT AND SUCH OTHER MATTERS AS PROVIDED BY LAW AND DECLARING DAVID FREDENDALL AS ELECTED MEMBER OF THE CITY COUNCIL, REPRESENTING DISTRICT 2, FOR THE FULL TERM OF FOUR YEARS (TERM: MARCH 2020 - MARCH 2024)**

**THE CITY COUNCIL  
City of Glendora, California**

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY GLENDORA DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:**

**WHEREAS**, a By-District General Municipal Election coincided with the Presidential Primary Election was held and conducted in the City of Glendora, California, on Tuesday, March 3, 2020, as required by law; and

**WHEREAS**, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

**WHEREAS**, the County Election Department canvassed the returns of the election and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached and made a part hereof as "Exhibit A."

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GLENDORA, CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

**SECTION 1.** That the whole number of votes (ballots) cast in the precincts except *vote by mail* voter ballots and provisional ballots was 980,875.

That the whole number of *vote by mail and provisional voter ballots* cast in the City was 1,141,594, making a total of 2,122,469 ballots cast in the City.

**SECTION 2.** That the names of persons on the ballot for the election for Member of the City Council for the election is as follows:

**SECTION 3.** That the votes received by the names of persons on the ballot for the election for Member of the City Council, District 2 is as follows:

**SECTION 4.** That the number of votes given at each precinct and the number of votes given in the City to each of the persons above named for the respective offices for which the persons were candidates were as listed in Exhibit "A" attached.

**SECTION 5.** The City Council does declare and determine that as a result of the election: **DAVID FREDENDALL** was elected as a Member of the City Council, to represent District 2 for the full term of four years.

**SECTION 6.** The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of \*votes (ballots) cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person(s); (5) The total number of votes given to each person, and for and against each measure.

**SECTION 7.** That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each of the persons so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribe to it and file it in the office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

**SECTION 8.** That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.


