DEMOLITIONSUBMITTAL CHECKLIST

Contact the Planning Division for use and development information prior to preparing any plans. Some projects may require special review and approval before a permit can be issued.

A permit application, construction documents, and a plan check fee are required to be submitted to the Building Division. Work shall not commence until plans have been reviewed and approved, a permit has been issued, and required pedestrian protection measures are in place.

	5 feet or more, but exceeding one half the construction height	None
