## **Hydrant Meter Rental Process**

- 1. Complete Fire Hydrant Meter Rental Agreement City Hall
- Must have a current City of Glendora business City Hall City Business Licenses can be obtained through HDL – (626) 513-0043
- 3. Go to Fire Station for sign off
  - a. Station #151- 231 W Mountain View Ave (626)963-2722
     West on Foothill
     North/Right on Vermont West/Left on Mountain View
  - b. Station#85-650 E Gladstone-(626)963- 1821 South on Glendora East/Left on Gladstone
  - c. Station #86 520 Amelia -(626)963-1821 East on Foothill (All the way to the end) South/Right on Amelia
- 4. Pay Deposit City Hall \$1851.00
- Pick up Meter at the yard 1051 E Sierra Madre East on Foothill North/Left on Loraine West/Left on Sierra Madre

1. All water used oth	ner than throug	gh a service co	onnection and meter shall be through a fire hydrant meter. The applica		

- ant shall deposit \$1,851.00 with the City for such service and shall pay a \$100.00 minimum charge per month or portion thereof for such use. Water used shall be at the rate according to the zone that the Hydrant is used in.
- 2. The applicant is responsible for any damage or loss of the fire hydrant meter or attached eddy valve. The cost for repair or replacement will be retained from the \$1851.00 deposit. Any balance due will be billed on an invoice & sent to applicant.
- 3. Hydrant meters are rented for period not to exceed one guarter (three months). The City reserves the right to recall the meter after one quarter (3 months) for reading and examination. An additional deposit may be required after the one quarter period.
- 4. Hydrant meters and eddy valves shall be used whenever water is taken from a fire hydrant. Failure to use the proper valve is a violation of Section 499 of the California Penal Code and is subject to a fine of \$50.00.
- 5. ALL PERSONS CONDUCTING BUSINESS IN THE CITY OF GLENDORA MUST FIRST OBTAIN A BUSINESS LICENSE BEFORE COMMENCING WORK.
