DISCLAIMER

Rebates are limited to 2,500 square feet or \$10,000 per commercial site. No impermeable surfaces will be included in the square footage. To receive a reservation for the Non-Functional Turf Rebate Program, you must have existing turf. If your project has already been started or completed, you are not eligible for a rebate. Bare dirt does not qualify for a rebate. Areas previously covered by other plants or surfaces will NOT be considered as a part of the rebate. Rebate amount NOT to exceed purchase price plus tax.

By participating in the program, you waive and release the City of Glendora and their contractors and agents from any and all claims and causes of action arising out of the removal of turf and/or the purchase, installation or uses of devices in connection with this Non-Functional Turf Rebate Program. Any claim you may have based upon any defect or failure of performance of a contracted service or device purchased by you should be pursued with the contractor or manufacturer/distributor.

The City of Glendora only enforces the terms and conditions of the Non-Functional Turf Rebate Program. The applicant is responsible for complying will all applicable laws, codes, policies, covenants, conditions and restrictions that may apply. Quality, appearance, and maintenance of the converted area for 3 years, from date of installation, is the responsibility of the applicant.

This is a voluntary program. Rebates will only be provided if all of the conditions and terms have been met. Funding for the program may run out at any time. Submitting a rebate application does NOT guarantee a rebate. If the project is not completed by the date given with the "Rebate Number" upon approval to move forward, you forfeit your rebate. Final project notification must be RECEIVED completed on or before the deadline date. Final project notification received more than five (5) days after the deadline date, will be returned to the applicant and the rebate will NOT be honored. Participants in this program are not eligible for additional outdoor landscaping rebate incentives offered through the City of Glendora, Water Conservation Rebate Program.
